Course Description: Determination of adequate Sample Size is prime issue especially in medical research due to Ethical, Economical and Decisional consideration. Though, all three factors are very important in planning any research, yet the first and last one become indispensable in the light of sample size.

However, Design of Study is an integral part of sample size determination. Different study designs required sample size adjustments which is eventually very crucial for the power of study. *Since two workshops have already been conducted majorly on sample size therefore design of study will take more space in this workshop along with sample size determination.*
